- * Annual and ongoing review of the mission, values, and strategic plan.
- * Attendance at annual retreat and membership meeting, and any other long-range planning activities.

- **Responsibilities:**

- * Overseeing and monitoring the fiscal health of the CVFSC and to ensure the organization stays focused on achieving its mission.
- * Commit to volunteering for a minimum of 20 hours per year.

- **Community Relations:**

- * Build relationships that enhance and increase the CVFSC's reputation and represent the club's mission and vision within the SnoKing Renton facility and at events attended by our club members.

As a Board Member I understand that I have duties of care, loyalty, and obedience to the organization.

- * The Duty of Care is the duty to pay attention to the organization: to monitor its activities, see that its mission is being accomplished, and guard its financial resources.
- * The Duty of Loyalty is the duty to avoid conflicts of interest.
- * The Duty of Obedience is to carry out the purposes of the organization, and to comply with the law.
